


Step by step

From the Figma website home-screen, locate and click into the project you'd like to share with others.




From there, locate and click the "**Present**" button on the top right of


the screen.



Now in the presentation screen, locate and click the "Share Prototype" button on the top right.



Before sharing the link, make sure to change the link access from "Only people invited to this file" can access to "Anyone with the link" can view.



From here, use the "*Copy link*" button to get a shareable link for your testers!

If the link copied successfully, you should see the "*Link copied to clipboard*" message appear at the bottom of the screen.








STEP 7 (END)
