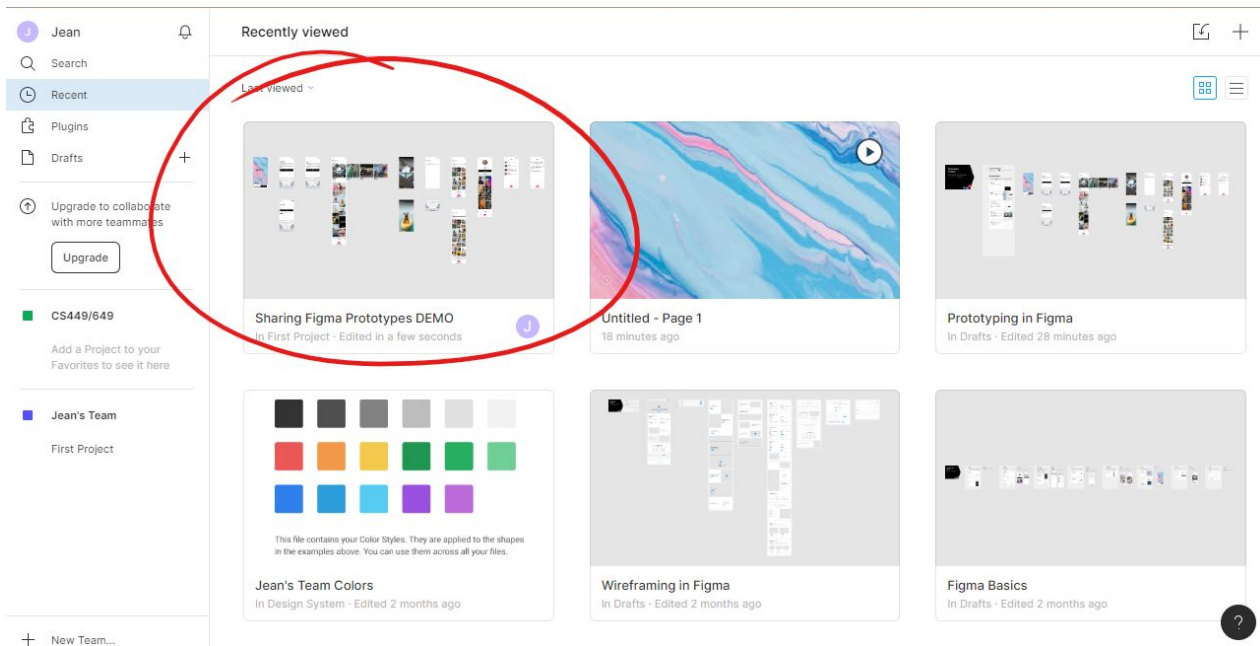


SHARING FIGMA PROTOTYPES

Step by step

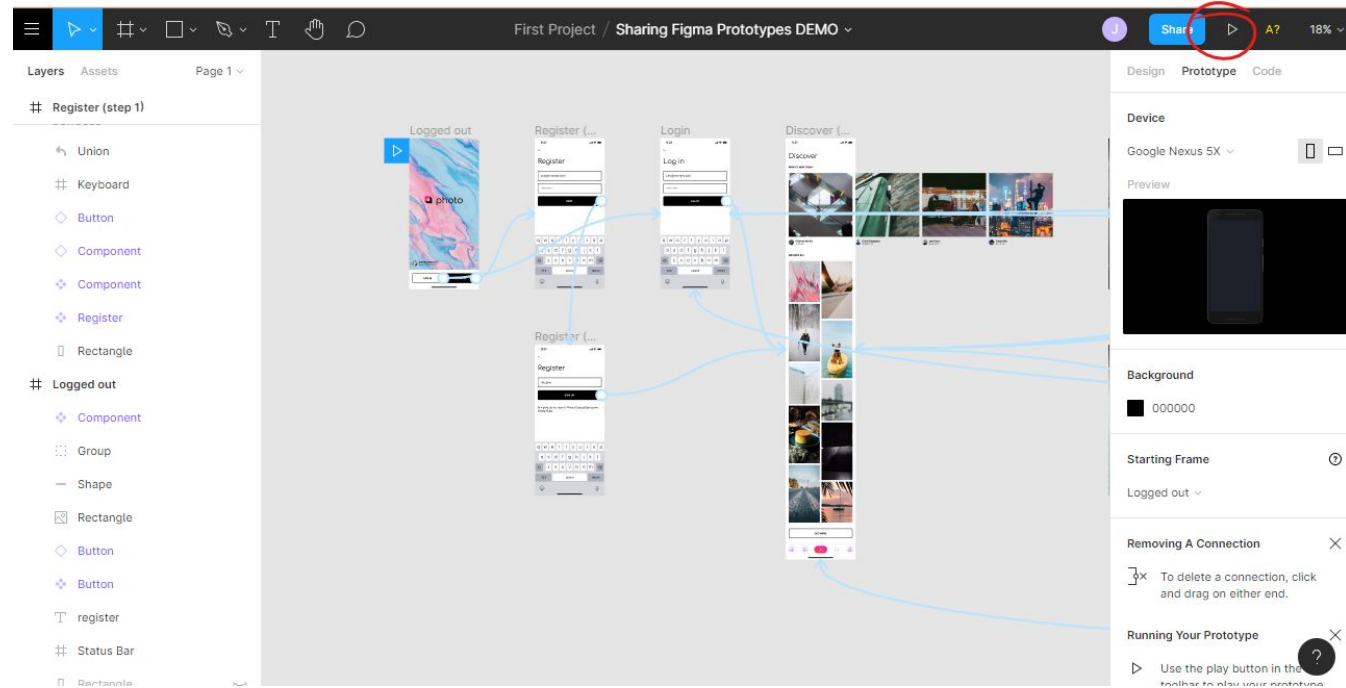
STEP 1

From the Figma website home-screen, locate and click into the project you'd like to share with others.



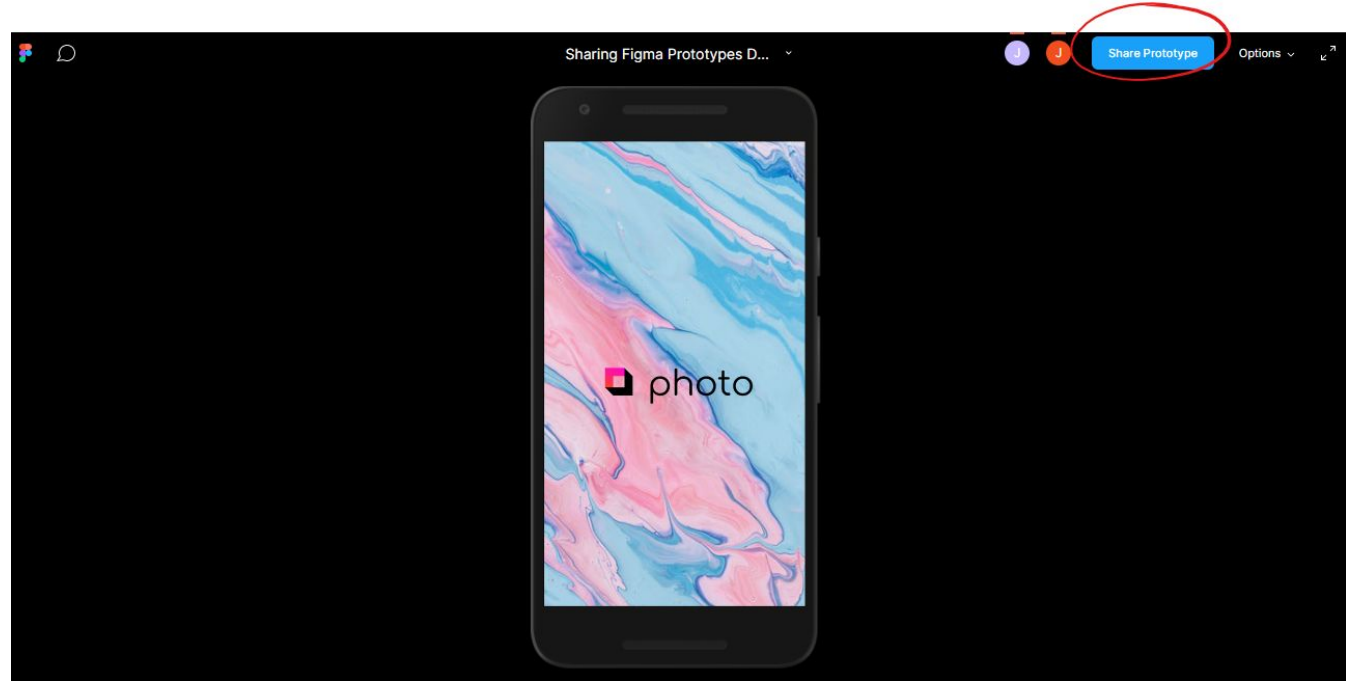
STEP 2

From there, locate and click the “**Present**” button on the top right of the screen.



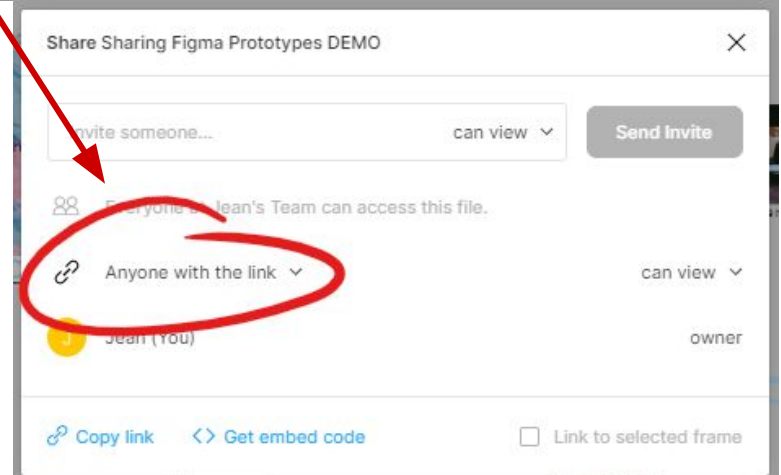
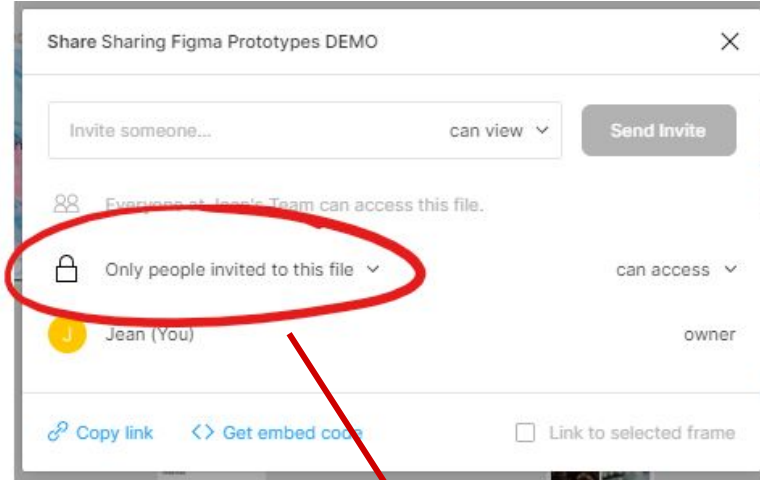
STEP 3

Now in the presentation screen, locate and click the “**Share Prototype**” button on the top right.



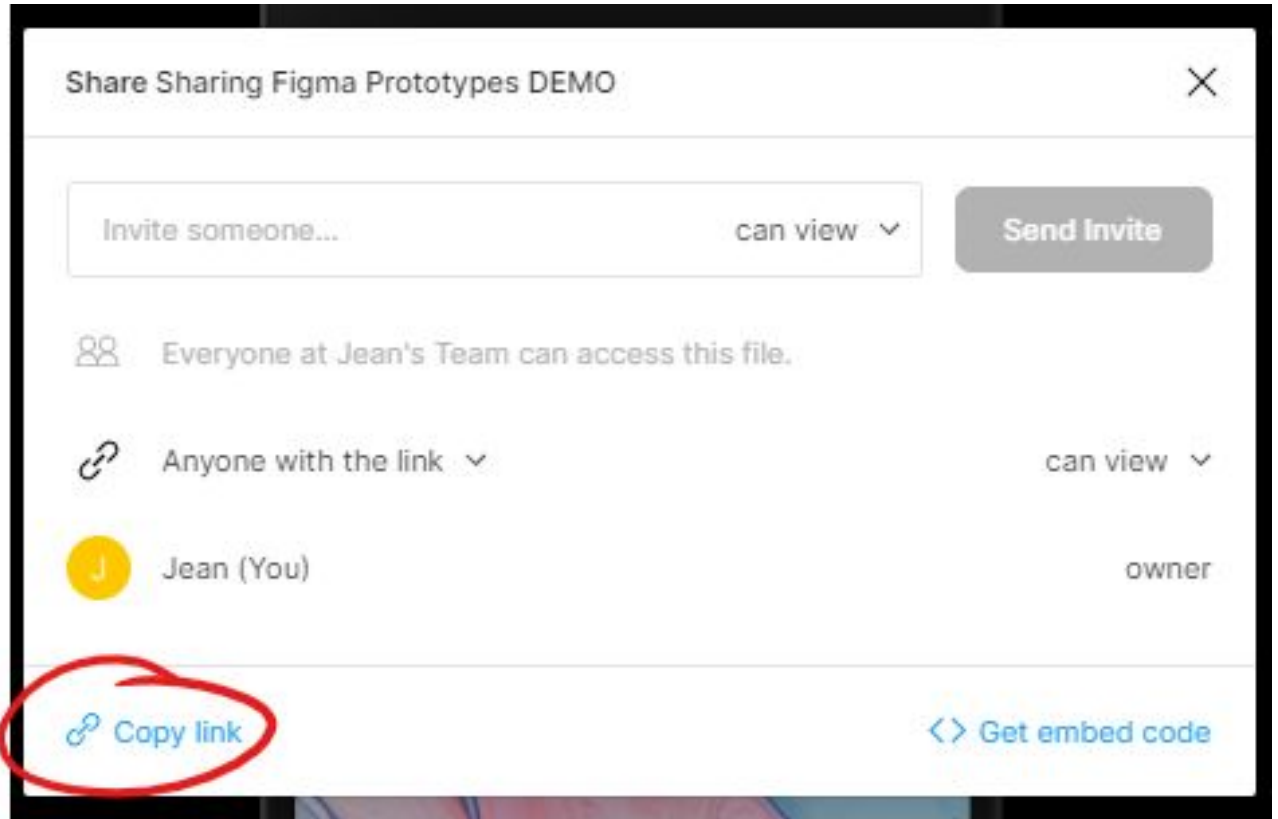
STEP 4

Before sharing the link, make sure to change the link access from “**Only people invited to this file**” can access to “**Anyone with the link**” can view.



STEP 5

From here, use the “**Copy link**” button to get a shareable link for your testers!



STEP 6

If the link copied successfully, you should see the “**Link copied to clipboard**” message appear at the bottom of the screen.

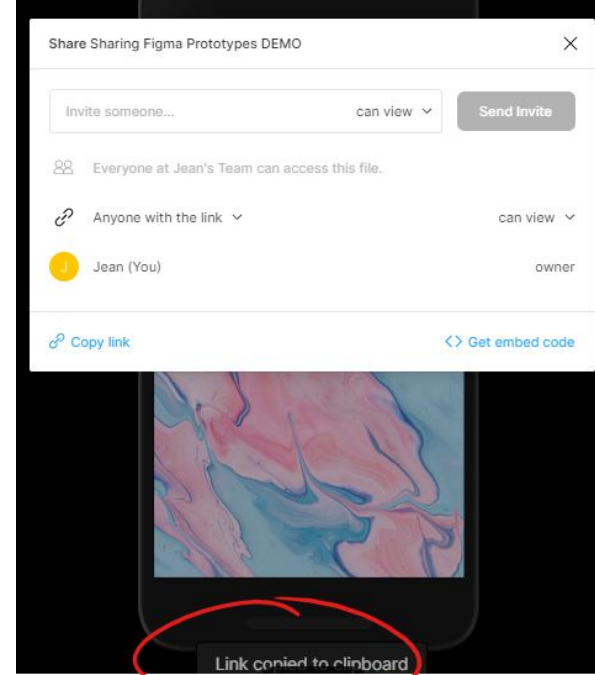

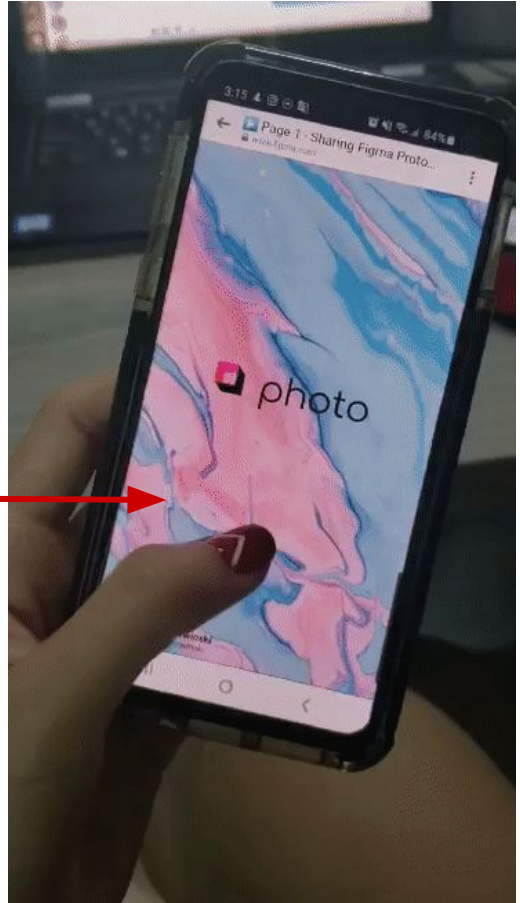
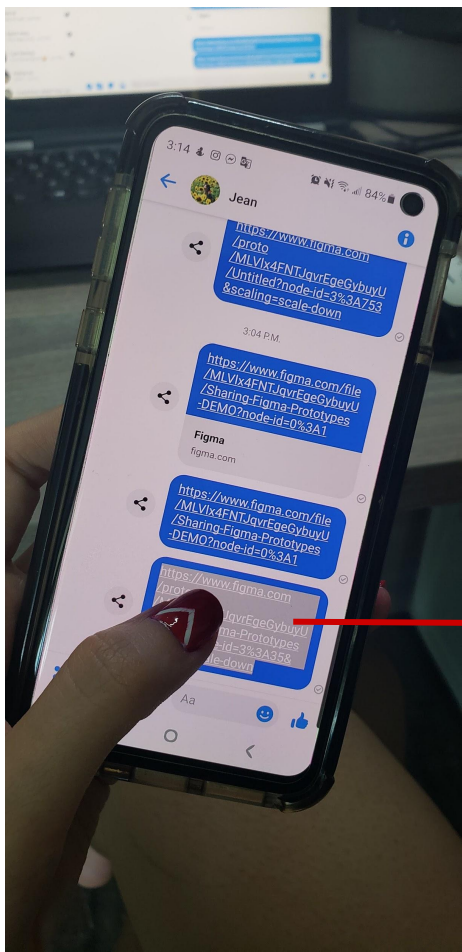

COMMON ERROR

Using the “*Share*” button directly from the project screen will bring testers to the project screen as well (*instead of the test screen where you’d like them to be*).
